About AHKNCRD

Akhtar Hameed Khan National Centre for Rural Development (AHKNCRD) was established as a Federal Training and Research Institution in the year 1979. It is functioning as an Executive Department of the Establishment Division, Government of Pakistan. In recognition of invaluable services rendered by late Dr. Akhtar Hameed Khan for the cause of community development and empowerment of the poor and marginalized people in Pakistan, Government of Pakistan renamed NCRD as Akhtar Hameed Khan National Center for Rural Development (AHKNCRD) in the year 2000. The activities of Centre focus on four major types of programmes:

- Training courses;
- Conferences, Seminars and Workshops;
- Learning and Research;
- Liaison with International Organizations.

Akhtar Hameed Khan National Centre for Rural Development (AHKNCRD), an Executive Department of Establishment Division, is responsible for promoting the cause of rural development in Pakistan through its programmes of training and research. Training is imparted, inter alia to officials of the Local Government and Rural Development Departments, elected representatives, functionaries of Nation Building Department (NBD's) in order to improve their professional skills. The Centre also liaises with various international agencies like African-Asian Rural Development Organization (AARDO), Centre on Integrated Rural Development for Asia and the Pacific (CIRDAP), and other such organizations engaged in rural uplift endeavors.

The Centre is situated on Park Road, Chak Shahzad, Islamabad. The Campus is spread over an area of 12.5 acres of land comprising administrative block, auditorium, conference room, classrooms, library, hostel, residential colony, nursery area and orchards.

The Annual Training Plan 2025-26 highlights the details of training programmes planned to be organized during the current financial year.

No training fee is charged from the training participants; however, the departments/organizations of the nominees bear the costs of TA & DA etc., if applicable. Hostel accommodation for participants is available on double occupancy basis on approved rates and first-come-first-served basis, Mess facility is also available on self-finance basis in the hostel.

The Centre also extends logistical, secretarial and faculty support to other national and international organizations for seminars, workshops and training courses.
